OPEN NET:

This net is part of the National Traffic System and is a controlled net; therefore, all responses and comments will be directed to the Net Control Station. After NTS functions are completed, a CARA rag chew session will be held. After the CARA rag chew session, the ARES® session will begin. - (5) We will now start our first round of comments. <u>Call on each call that checked in</u>. Does anyone have any amateur radio news/magazine articles? Or a trivia question for discussion? <u>Take trivia question now if there is one.</u>
- (6) Are there any further check ins?
- (7) We will start our second round of questions or comments. <u>If trivia question, take answers to question on second round.</u> After last response to trivia question, give/get <u>answer.</u>
- (8) Would the Guernsey County Emergency Coordinator or AEC like to assume control of the net at this time for training or other purposes? <u>NOTE: The County E.C. or AEC may assume Net Control at this time if they have reason to believe an emergency exists; otherwise, they should return control to originating station after their session.</u>
- (9) Are there any final check in's or comments?
